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SYLLABUS

In this Connections class, we will be focusing on Middle School Math skills important for mastery of grade level. In most cases, there is a class with scholars in 6th-7th grade and an additional class of 7th-8th grade scholars. Students use the Math 180 program in both classes.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

Chromebooks: Used Daily with Math 180 Software and Google Classroom

Notebook: Keep a section of your math notebook for Math Connections **Paper:** Need available for class

Pencils- 2-3 sharpened pencils should be available for class each day. Be prepared !

Dry Erase Markers—Optional to have own set **Earbuds/Headphones:** Needed daily

Other Supplies: Mrs. Fisher may ask for some supplies to use for activities in class.

GRADING: *Participation will count HEAVILY toward a scholar's average in this class. It is important that scholars complete assignments and be productive in class, using a Growth Mindset. Homework will not be assigned in this class, however, some review links may be shared through Google Classroom to assist with Content Review. Math Inventory and other methods of assessment will be used to determine proficiency of skills during the semester.*

Participation: 50% Classwork/Homework: 40% Assessment: 10%

ABSENCES: It is important that scholars check for missing assignments upon returning to school from an absence. Scholars should consult Mrs. Fisher. ATTENDANCE is IMPERATIVE in this class due to most assignments and activities taking place during class. Please do your best to be present.

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS: All scholars will have a Classroom Expectations sheet for Math Connections class. Parents and scholars should read and discuss what is listed. Math Connections will follow the enforced Odyssey Charter School Behavior Management Plan. 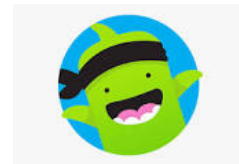


Class Dojo
