Growth Mindset Tips: It is the belief that intelligence and abilities can be developed through dedication and work.

- Give growth mindset feedback (Praise the effort involved in a task)
- Talk about the value of mistakes as learning opportunities (Learn from your mistakes to improve)
- Teach your child to recognize a "fixed mindset voice" and replace it with a "growth mindset voice." (Fixed: I give up Growth: I will try)
- Ask guestions to help your child think and solve problems for himself or herself. (Assist through the process rather than giving the answer)
- Be a growth mindset role model (Share your efforts in working through challenging tasks)
